

INDIAN CAMP CREEK PARK FACILITIES

LAKESIDE PAVILION - With a gorgeous lakeside view, this hexagonal-shaped pavilion creates the perfect backdrop for keepsake photos, small weddings, and other special events. The site is rentable in minimum two-hour increments for \$60 per session.

PICNIC SHELTERS - Several picnic shelters are available for rental and accommodate up to 100 guests. These shelters offer electric service, picnic tables, grills, and nearby playgrounds and restrooms. Fees range from \$35 to \$60, depending on the size of the shelter and date of the rental.

TRAILS - Crossing prairie lowlands and wooded hillsides, more than eight miles of natural surface trail are open to walkers, runners, bicyclists, and horses. In addition, a one-mile paved and boardwalk trail surrounds the lake at the center of the park.

FISHING - A six-acre lake in the center of the park is stocked with bluegill, bass, and catfish. Fishing within the park is governed by the laws of the state of Missouri. Fishing is permissible in Big Creek, which serves as the park's northern boundary, and the Indian Camp Creek that flows through the park.

YOUTH-GROUP CAMPING - Set aside for group camping, several large plots are open for use by youth organizations (scouts, church groups, and schools). In addition to camp space, the site offers a picnic shelter, restrooms, and a central amphitheater/fire ring. A flat fee is charged for up to 100 guests, with additional charges for more campers.

HERITAGE SITES - A large portion of what is now Indian Camp Creek Park was settled by Joseph Cannon in 1812. The Cannon family cemetery provides a glimpse into the family's heritage. In addition, a restored grain silo near the replicated remains of a log cabin home provides a picturesque view of the surrounding community.

RESERVATIONS - Must be 21 years of age to rent any facility. Payments are accepted via cash, check, MasterCard, or VISA. Reservations are accepted online, by phone, or at the park office.

INDIAN CAMP CREEK PARK

Situated at the confluence of Big Creek and Indian Camp Creek in northwestern St. Charles County, Indian Camp Creek Park is our largest park at more than 600 acres in size. It features prairie, vast wooded hills, and protected habitat for the deer, turkey, quail, and other wildlife found throughout the park. It also presents a look into the region's history - which, evidence shows, was a native American community in the Mississippian Period (1000 to 1400 AD).



Indian Camp Creek Park offers a host of amenities that are seldom found anywhere else in St. Charles County. Among the unique features are a nature-themed playground at the center of the park and several miles of multi-use, natural trail. Additional development has brought youth-group camping facilities with a central amphitheater, a restored silo tower that overlooks the park and the surrounding countryside, and an interpretive site to honor the region's history. Future improvement will add areas designated to restore native species of flora and fauna. In addition to these distinctive features, the park also offers picnic shelters, a fishing lake, and other features designed to enhance the natural surroundings.



Directions: From Interstate 70, go north on Highway 61 for seven miles to Dietrich Road (on left). Turn left on Dietrich Road to the park entrance.
