

QUAIL RIDGE PARK FACILITIES

QUAIL RIDGE LODGE - The Quail Ridge Lodge is available for rental throughout the week and accommodates up to 180 guests for weddings, family functions, and corporate events. The 3,600 square-foot facility has a “warming” kitchen, a vaulted ceiling, and a wooden deck that overlooks the nearby gazebo. Fees vary depending on the rental, but range from \$250 to \$650 (plus a \$250 damage deposit).

PICNIC SHELTERS - Several picnic shelters are available for rental and accommodate up to 200 guests. These shelters offer electric service, picnic tables, grills, and nearby playgrounds and restrooms. Fees range from \$35 to \$200, depending on the size of the shelter and date of the rental.

TRAILS - Winding through and along the hardwood forests of a former farm pasture, three miles of paved trail and four miles of natural surface trail are open to walkers, runners, and bicyclists.

FISHING - Two lakes are open to fishing and are stocked with bluegill, bass, and catfish. Fishing within the park is governed by the laws of the state of Missouri.

DISC GOLF COURSE - An 18-hole disc golf course is open throughout the year.

OFF-LEASH DOG AREA - A three-acre fenced area is open to dogs for off-leash play. Guests must adhere to all posted rules when using the facility, and dogs must remain on leash outside the area.

NHPA HALL OF FAME & MUSEUM - Located near the park entrance, the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association Hall of Fame houses a museum displaying memorabilia and trophies, 16 indoor pitching courts, and other amenities.

RESERVATIONS - Must be 21 years of age to rent any facility. Payments are accepted via cash, check, MasterCard, or VISA. Reservations are accepted online, by phone, or at the park office.

QUAIL RIDGE PARK

Opened as the first St. Charles County Park in July 2000, Quail Ridge Park is 250 acres of rolling prairie, wooded hillsides, and rich bottomland along Peruque Creek. This diverse terrain provides a wonderful backdrop to enjoy the great outdoors. Trails wind throughout the park to provide visitors with a first-hand opportunity to view songbirds, deer, turkey, and other wildlife in their natural environments.



Park amenities include an indoor lodge, group and individual picnic shelters, playgrounds, walking/bicycle trails, a three-acre lake, an 18-hole disc golf course, a small fishing pond, and an Off-Leash Dog Area.



The park also serves as home to the National Horseshoe Pitchers Hall of Fame and Museum, featuring several courts open to public use.

Devoted to maintaining the value of the land on which our parks are built, the Parks Department has developed dedicated wetlands and natural prairie areas within Quail Ridge Park. Three pools, totaling approximately nine acres, have been adapted from farm pasture into wetlands that provide habitat for many species of wildlife and plants. The 18-acre prairie located in the center of the park is designed to display native plants and animals common to the area.


